During the pandemic, I partnered with Ottawa Public Health to set up pop-up vaccination sites. I partnered with Lyft ride-sharing services to ensure that everyone could get to the vaccination clinics at no cost should they not be able to afford a way there. In 2019, the City of Ottawa awarded me a Healthy Community Champions Award for helping set up a "Party Safe" campaign and hosting evenings demonstrating how to use Naloxone in an overdose situation. The community has always come first for me and I will always continue to do it that way.

We need to review the transit situation in Ottawa. Not just public transit but accessible transit as well too. Our population is aging and as time continues to move forward, more and more of our residents will need a reliable, fully accessible transit solution. This of course also falls under other pieces of city infrastructure that need to be reviewed.

Affordable housing and leadership to assist those that are facing a homelessness crisis are key as well. We need to focus on helping those with mental health and substance use health as well.

We also need to work as a municipality with the Provincial and Federal governments on climate change. All three levels of government will have to play a role in combatting climate change or we will continue to see damaging weather and storms tear through our communities.
